

Event Regulations "Regulations of the Charity Auction Held as Part of The 28th Urtica for Children Foundation Gala 2025"

§ 1

General Provisions

1. These regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations") define the general terms and conditions of participation in the Charity Auction conducted by the Urtica for Children Foundation as part of The 28th Urtica for Children Foundation Gala 2025.

2. Whenever the Regulations refer to:

a) Auction – this shall be understood as the Charity Auction organized by the Urtica for Children Foundation during the 28th Urtica for Children Foundation Gala 2025, during which works of art specified in the auction album prepared by the organizer and made available before the annual Auction on the website www.urticadzieciom.pl and delivered in printed form to all bidders will be auctioned; b) Small Auction – this means an auction during which works of art will be auctioned, as specified in the auction album listing the Small Auction Items dedicated to the Small Auction, prepared by the Organizer and published prior to the annual Auction on the website www.urticadzieciom.pl and delivered in printed form to all bidders.

c) Gala or Event – this means The 28th Urtica for Children Foundation Gala 2025, along with the Auction;

d) Organizer – this shall mean the Urtica for Children Foundation, with its registered office in Wrocław at ul. Krzemieniecka 120, 54-613 Wrocław, Poland, entered into the Register of Associations, Other Social and Professional Organizations, Foundations, and Independent Public Healthcare Facilities maintained by the District Court for Wrocław – Fabryczna in Wrocław, 6th Division of the National Court Register, under KRS number 0000693315, REGON number: 368183691, NIP number: 8943113029, hereinafter also referred to as the "Foundation";

e) Auctioneer – this shall mean the person authorized by the Organizer to conduct the Auction on its behalf;

f) Auction Participant – this shall mean the person or legal entity participating in the auction during the Gala at Zamek Topacz;

g) Auction Item – this means works of art created during the "Sunny Gallery" workshops by children and young people who are patients of pediatric oncology and hematology departments;

h) Sunny Gallery – this means art therapy workshops conducted at the Foundation's initiative, during which children and adolescents residing in pediatric oncology and hematology wards, under the guidance of art therapists, create artwork that is then donated to the Auction.

3. The Foundation owns the artwork donated free of charge to the Auction, which is the Auction Item, including the copyrights to the artwork.

4. All proceeds from the Auction will be allocated to the Foundation's statutory purposes, including primarily:

a. Providing material and financial assistance to pediatric oncology and hematology facilities throughout Poland;

b. Providing material and financial assistance to children and adolescents with cancer and their families;

c. financing and conducting health, educational, and charitable initiatives, in particular art therapy workshops (i.e., "Sunny Gallery"), oncology consultations, sports activities, and therapeutic camps for children and adolescents with cancer and their families (i.e., "Urtica for Children Camp").

§ 2

Terms of Participation in the Auction

1. The 28th Urtica for Children Foundation Gala 2025 will take place on November 20, 2025, with live coverage from Zamek Topacz. The entire event will be broadcast online. Information about the date and location of the Auction will also be announced on the website www.urtica.dzieciom.pl or on the Foundation's Facebook page.

2. The Auction is closed.

3. The Auction Participants are guests invited by the Foundation to take part in the Gala, who are natural persons who are at least 18 years of age and have full legal capacity, legal entities and organizational units without legal personality but which can acquire rights and incur obligations in their own name - represented by authorized persons.

4. Actions that could hinder, destabilize, or prevent the conduct of this Auction are prohibited. If such actions are observed, the Auctioneer has the right to eliminate the Participant from further bidding.

5. Gala Participants consent to their image being recorded and broadcast.

§ 3

Duration and Course of the Gala and Auction

1. The Gala and Auction will be held in person and broadcast online.

2. The Auction will be preceded by a presentation of the works auctioned during the Gala in an auction album provided to Participants, as well as a presentation immediately before the auction of each work.

3. The Auction is scheduled to begin at 6:00 PM and end at 9:30 PM.

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4. Before bidding, the Auctioneer will present the terms and conditions to Participants.
5. The Auctioneer opens the Auction by proposing a minimum starting price for a given auctioned work, previously agreed with the Organizer, or by inviting participants to propose any starting price for a given work.
6. Each Participant may bid on any number of paintings.
7. Bid/increment amounts should be given in full Polish zlotys.
8. The increment bid offered by Participants is public to other Auction Participants.
9. The first and each subsequent bid submitted by an Auction Participant is legally binding and cannot be withdrawn.
10. A bid submitted during the Auction ceases to be binding if another Auction Participant submits a bid that is more favorable to the Organizer.
11. The auction for a given work is won by the Participant (hereinafter referred to as the "Winner") who has submitted the highest bid by the time the bidding for the work ends (by calling out the Participant's bid three times).
12. The Participant is responsible for the price offers submitted by himself or on behalf of the entity he represents. In particular, the Participant should ensure that he does not submit offers recklessly, mistakenly or without familiarizing himself with and understanding the consequences of submitting an offer in accordance with these Regulations and the provisions of Polish law.
13. The Organizer reserves the right to withdraw a given work from the Auction if there are no bids from Participants or if the starting price for a given work is not met. In the case described in the preceding sentence, the Organizer may also decide to submit the work to an online auction.
14. The winner of the auction for a given work does not have the right to cancel the bid.
15. Ownership of the auctioned work passes to the Winner upon payment of the bid amount.
16. The winner of the auction for a given work is obligated to pay the declared amount within 30 days of the Auction date. Payment is deemed made on the date the Organizer's bank account is credited.
17. Payments should be made to the Foundation's account in Polish złoty, to the following bank account number: 72 1050 0086 1000 0090 3133 5228, with the following description: "Donation – Urtica for Children's Auction XXVIII Gala 2025".
18. The artwork will be released to all Auction Winners on the date and in the manner agreed with the Organizer, but no later than December 31, 2025, after confirmation of payment of the declared amount to the Foundation's account or after the Winner has submitted an appropriate Declaration obliging

them to pay the aforementioned amount to the Foundation's account for the auctioned artwork.

19. The artwork will be released as follows: The Organizer will send the auctioned artwork by courier to the address provided by the Winner in the auction confirmation.

20. The Organizer will cover the shipping costs within Poland.

21. The Organizer reserves the right to resolve any doubts regarding the interpretation of these Rules and Regulations related to the Auction.

§ 4

Complaint Procedure

1. The Participant may submit any complaints regarding the conduct or execution of the Auction or the received auctioned artwork within 30 days of the Auction's end by sending a written complaint (by registered mail) to the Organizer's address with the subject line "Charity Auction XXVIII Gala of the Urtica for Children Foundation 2025 – Complaint."

2. Complaints submitted after the deadline specified in section 1 above will not be considered.

3. Complaints should include information allowing identification and contact information for the complainant, a description of the event giving rise to the complaint, and the request along with the justification.

4. Complaints submitted by Auction Participants will be reviewed within 14 business days of receipt by the Foundation. The complainant will notify the Auction Participant of the review of the complaint in writing to the mailing address provided.

§ 5

Personal Data

Information on the principles of personal data processing is included in Appendix 1 to the Regulations. Any amendment to this Appendix does not constitute an amendment to the Regulations and may be made by the Organizer at any time. Personal data of Event Participants will be deleted after the Auction has been conducted and settled.

§ 6

Final Provisions

2. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions and to cancel the Auction in

whole or in part without providing reasons until the Auction begins.

3. In matters not regulated by these Terms and Conditions, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.

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
